Shearing Ready Shed

Under health and safety law the woolgrower and the shearing contractor share responsibilities for the health and safety of a shearing team while they are at a shed. In regard to the shed environment and its plant and equipment, the woolgrower as the controller of the premises has a particular responsibility.

Therefore, before my team commences shearing at your property, I would like you to make sure that the shed and amenities are “*Shearing Ready*”. This will help to ensure smooth and efficient operation of your shearing contract, enable us both to meet our legal responsibilities and protect the health and safety of the shearing team.

I enclose a “Getting the Shed Ready for Shearing Checklist” to help you. Please complete this checklist and keep it for the start of shearing.

Just before shearing commences I will check health and safety in the shed. It would be a great help if you could also participate in this. I will make contact to find a time that suits you.
